# FORMOIL® 1021 Mould Release Oil

#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

FORMOIL® 1021 is a mould release agent containing mineral oil that prevents adhesion between fresh concrete and the mould, allowing for easy separation and resulting in a smooth-surfaced concrete finish.

#### **APPLICATION AREAS**

- On steel, plastic, and plywood moulds
- On mould surfaces with low or no absorbency
- In cases where improved mould handling and efficiency are desired

#### **FEATURES AND ADVANTAGES**

- Ensures clean and smooth-looking concrete surfaces
- Allows easy separation of the mould from the concrete
- · Facilitates mould cleaning
- · Does not leave stains on the mould
- Extends the service life of the mould

#### **TECHINCAL DATA**

Material Structure: Mineral Oil-BasedAppearance: Clear yellow liquid

Density (at 20°C): 0.85 kg/l
Flash Point / pH: >95°C / 6–7

These values are given for ambient conditions of +23±2°C temperature and 50±5% relative humidity.

## **APPLICATION METHOD**

Depending on the mould and weather conditions, the diluted mould oil should be applied to the moulds at least 3–4 hours before concrete is poured.

Application is done in a single, uniform coat using a **brush, roller, or spray**.

For consistent performance, a fine mist spray gun is recommended for a thin layer application. A second coat may be applied based on surface absorbency.

For best results, apply to form a thin film. Overuse may cause staining on the concrete surface.

## **DOSAGE**

With 1 litre of product:

On rough surfaces: 20–40 m²
On smooth surfaces: 40–80 m²

#### **PACKAGING**

- 30-litre plastic can
- 200-litre drum

#### WARNINGS

- Should be used between +5°C and +35°C.
- No foreign substances should be added to the prepared mortar.
- Expired mortar should not be reused with water
- Do not apply in areas exposed to direct sunlight or freezing conditions.

#### STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

- Store in a cool and dry environment, protected from sunlight and frost
- Shelf life is **12 months** in the original, unopened packaging.

# **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

- During application, wear protective workwear, gloves, goggles, and mask in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety regulations.
- Due to the irritating effects of cement-based materials, avoid contact with the skin and eyes.
- In case of contact, wash immediately with plenty of water and soap

- **Do not bring** food or beverages into the application area
